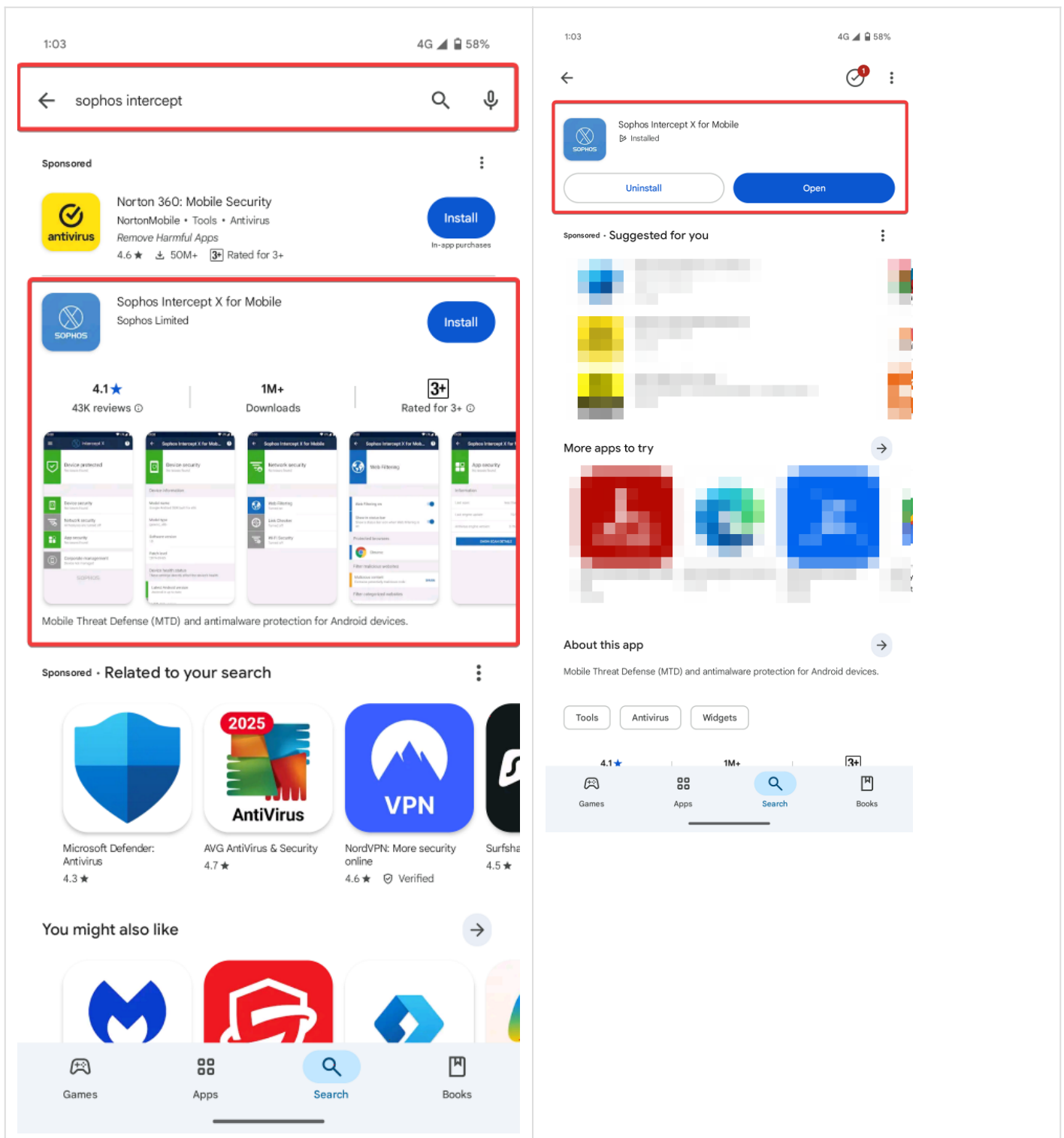


# Sophos VPN - MFA Guide using Sophos Intercept X

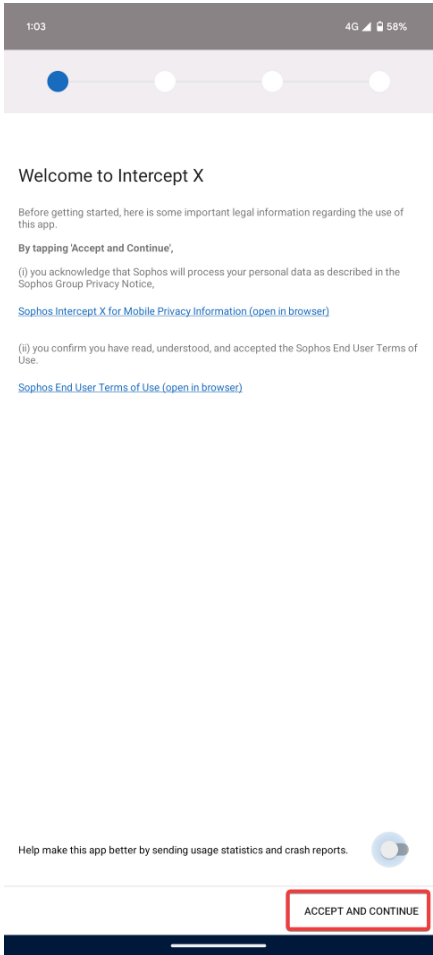
All images are from **Android / Google Pixel**, but the general process is the same on **Apple** phones.

1. Install the **Sophos Intercept X for Mobile** application.

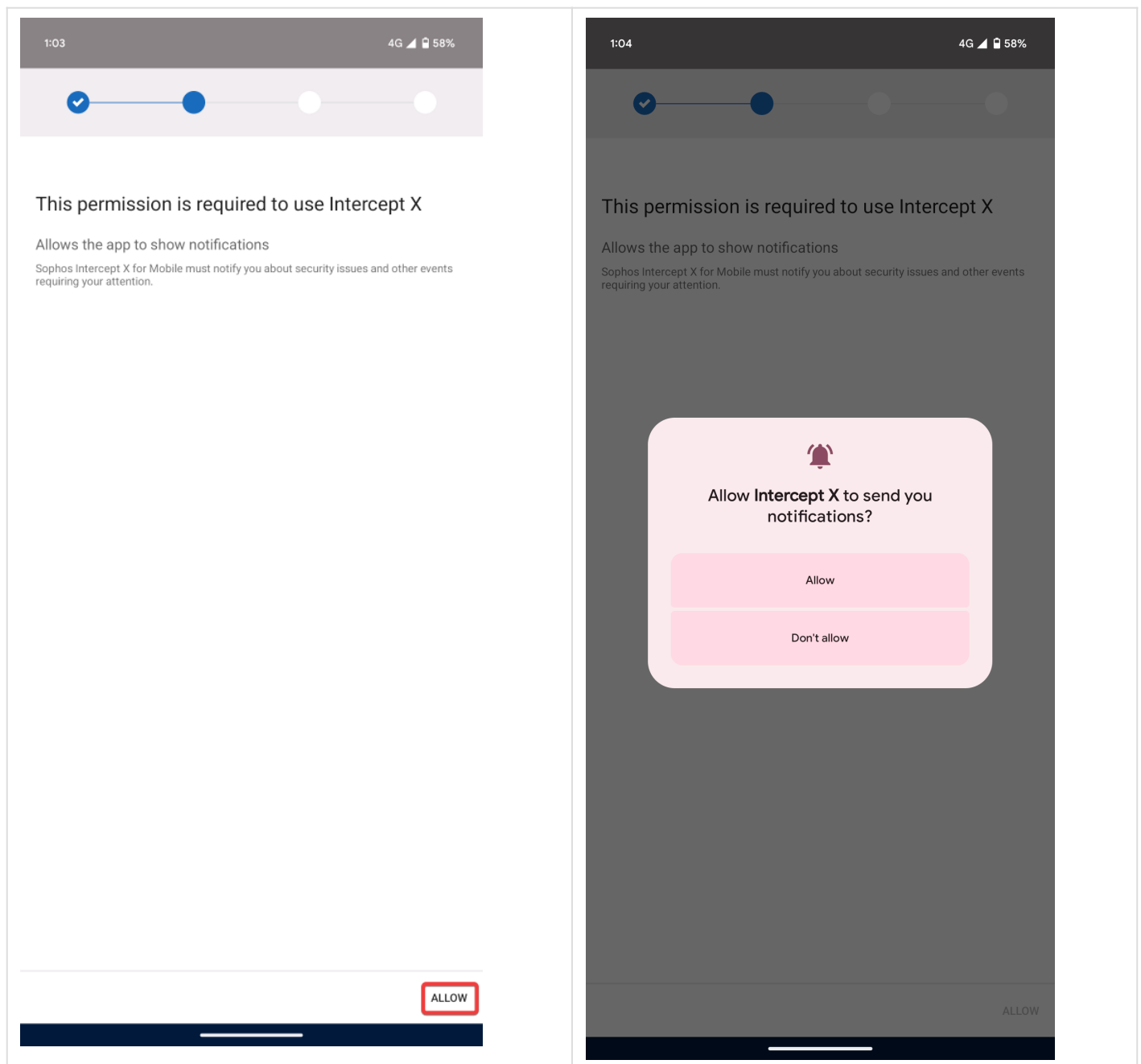

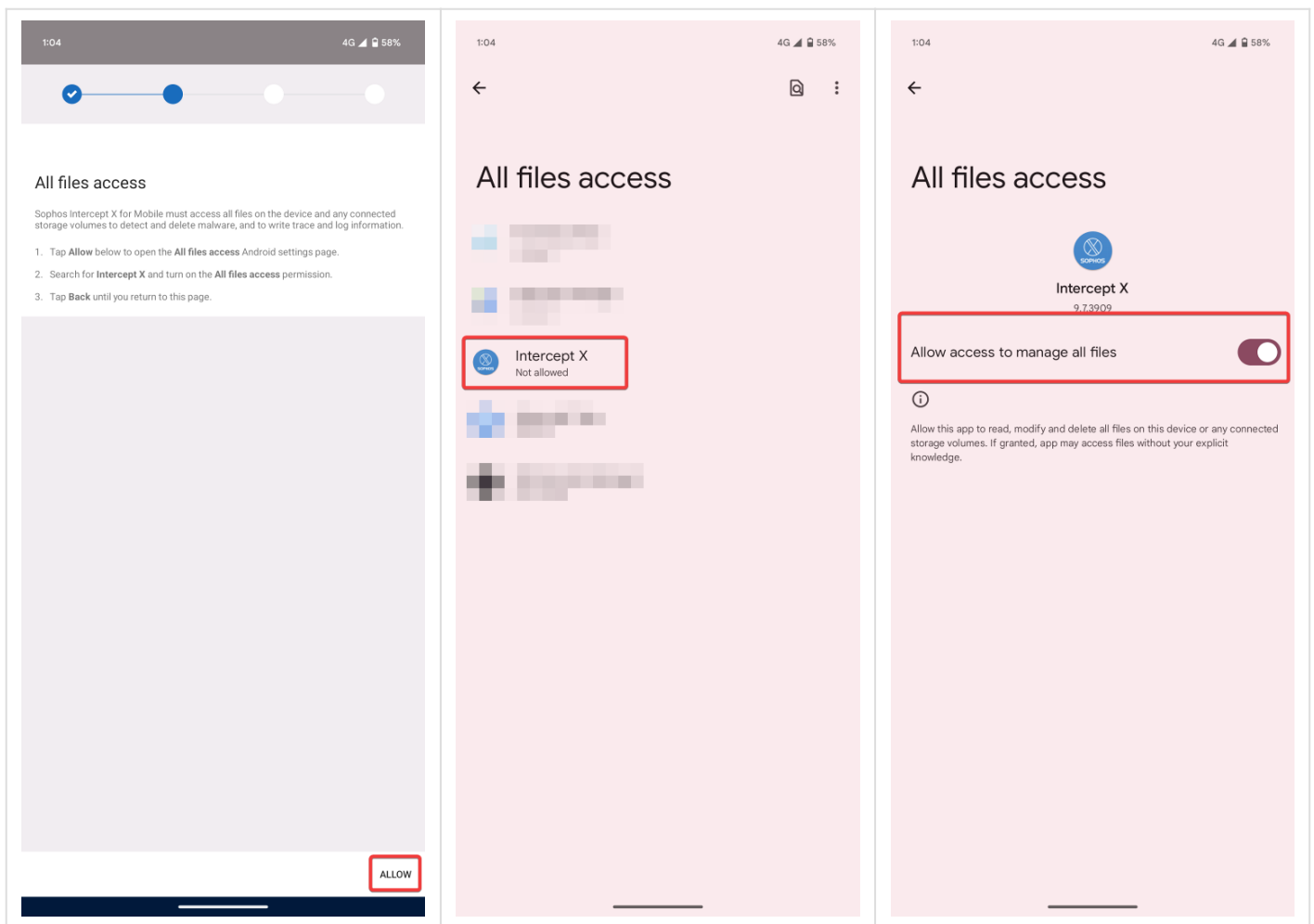
2. Open the application up, and **Accept and Continue** for the Terms of Use.



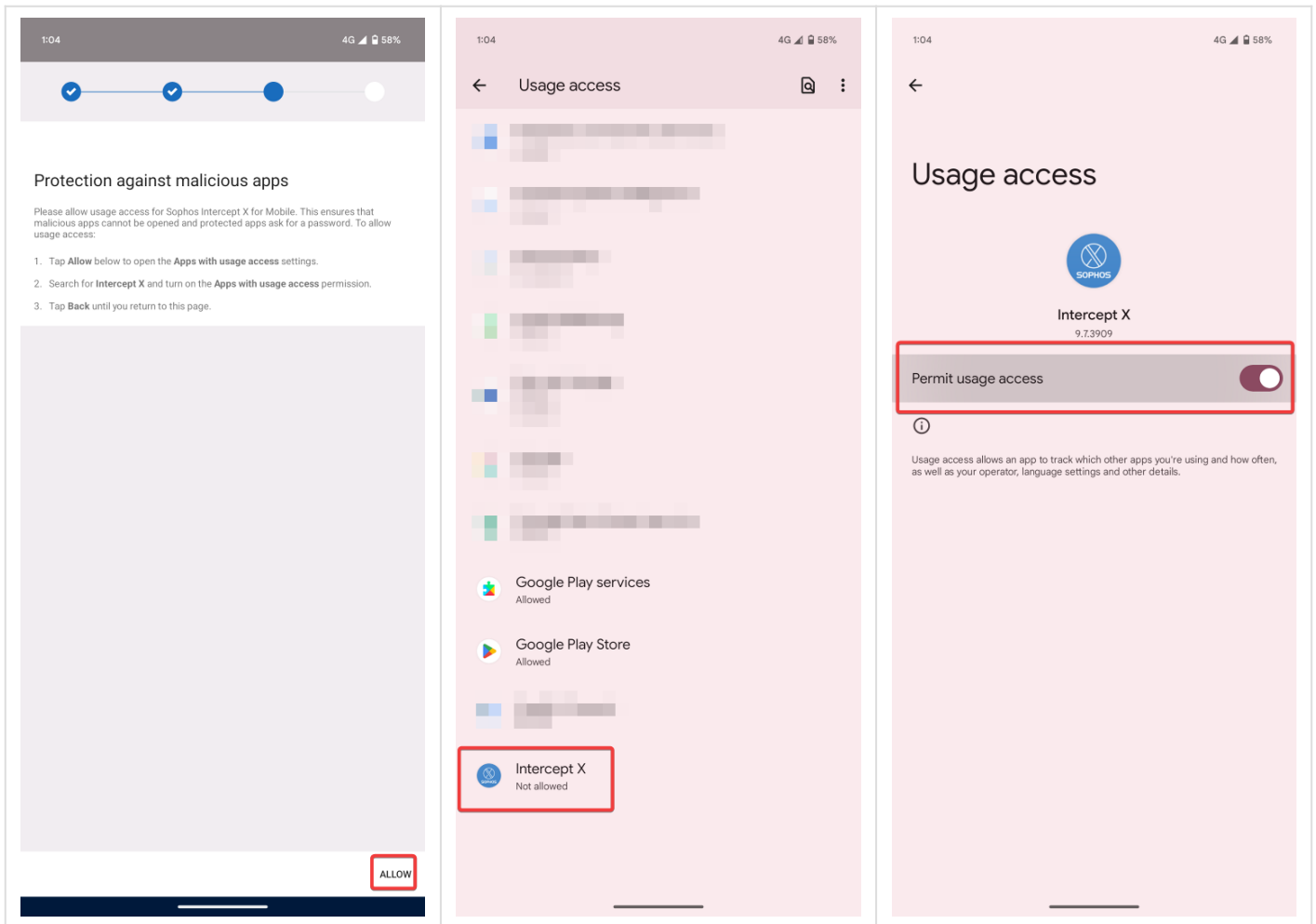
3. **Allow** the application to send you notifications.



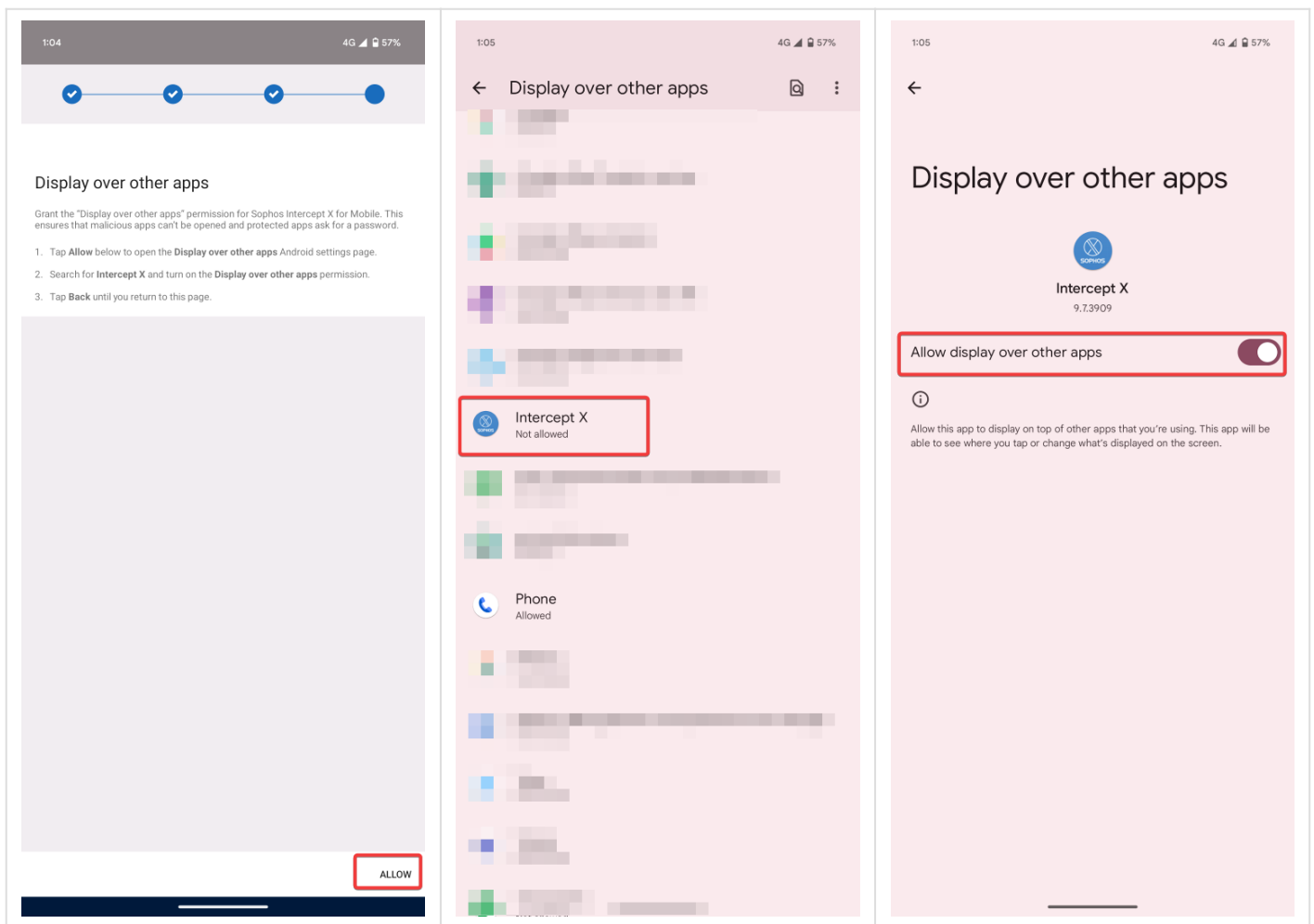
4. If prompted, **allow** access to all files. This is for the anti-virus functionality. (If you want, you can turn it off later)



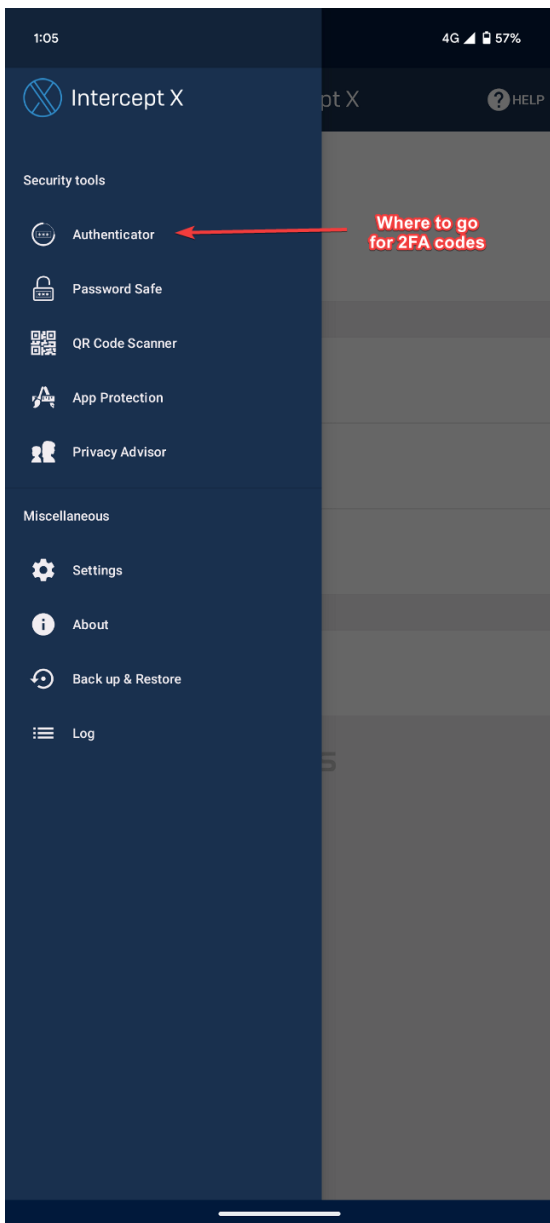
5. If prompted, **allow** usage access. This is for the anti-virus functionality.



6. If prompted, **allow** to display over other passwords. This is for the password manager functionality.

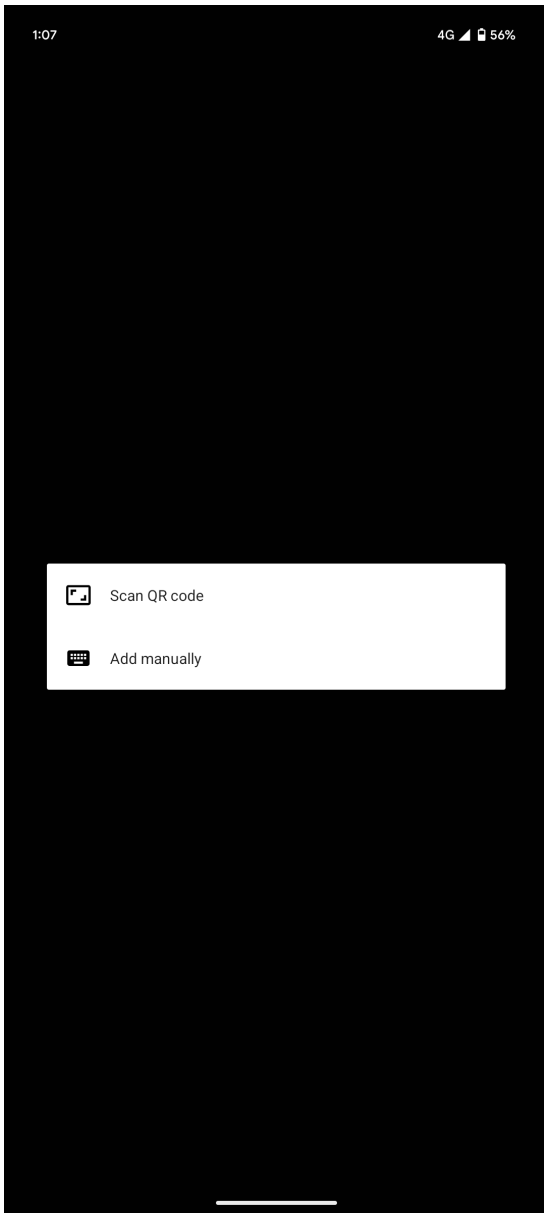


7. You should now see the home screen of Sophos Intercept X. Open the Hamburger menu at the top-left, you should see "**Authenticator**".



8. Go into the Authenticator, there should be nothing there, except a **(+)** bubble in the bottom right of the screen. Tap that, and then "Scan QR code". The application may ask you to use the camera, allow it access. This is just so you can scan the QR code.





9. You should now see a 6-digit MFA code that refreshes every 30 seconds or so with a new code. All finished!

## How do I turn off the anti-virus?

This is a bad idea, and it is generally recommended to have some form of malware protection. But if you already use a malware protection on your device, or are technically adept enough, go into the Settings in Intercept X, there are a lot of checkbox toggles to disable all functionality.
